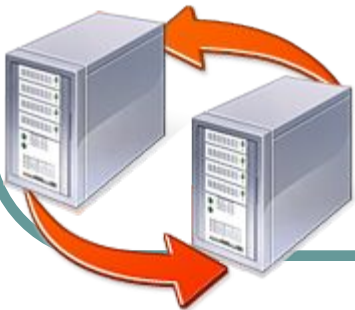

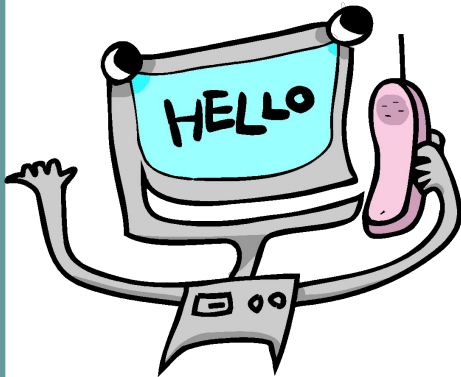

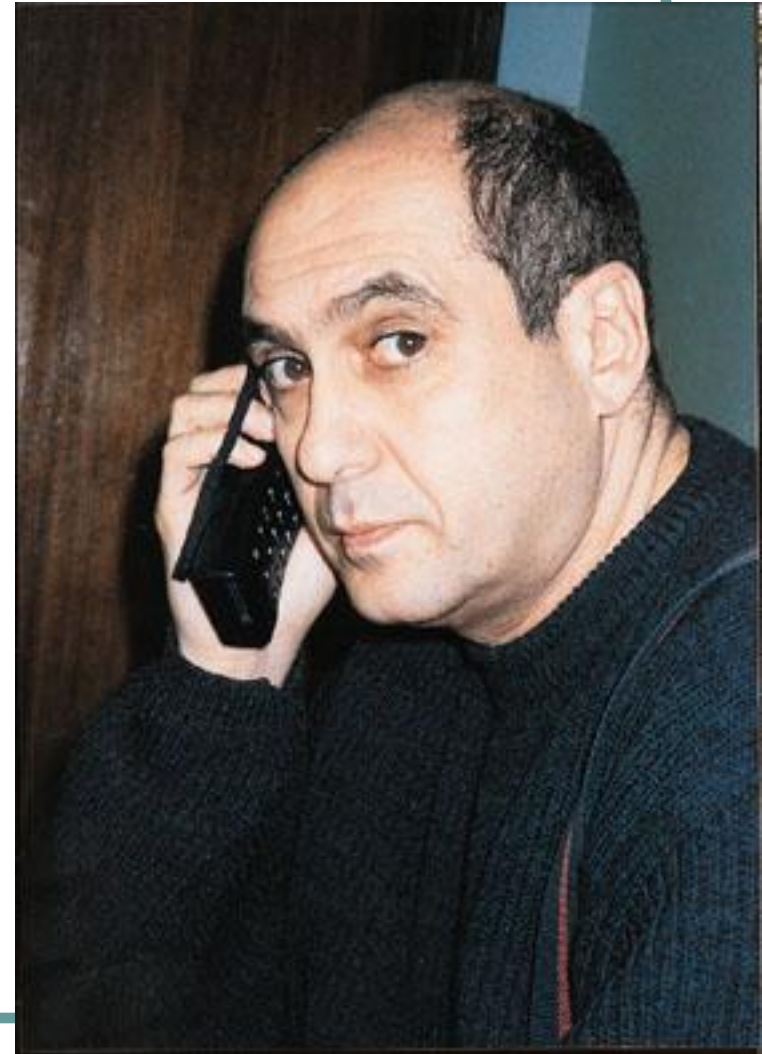
WHAT DO YOU HEAR IF A PERSON

WHAT DO THEY MEAN?

- **READ THE DEFFINITIONS

- **to join two telephone lines so that two people can speak**
- **to get connected**
- **when you speak to someone on the telephone**
- **to call sb on a mobile phone**

- a machine that records your telephone calls when you cannot answer them

- The action you make to answer the telephone call

- answering machine

- to lift (up) the receiver

- **to finish a telephone conversation**
- **to hang up,**

- **a short high sound**
