The major church of St. Petersburg

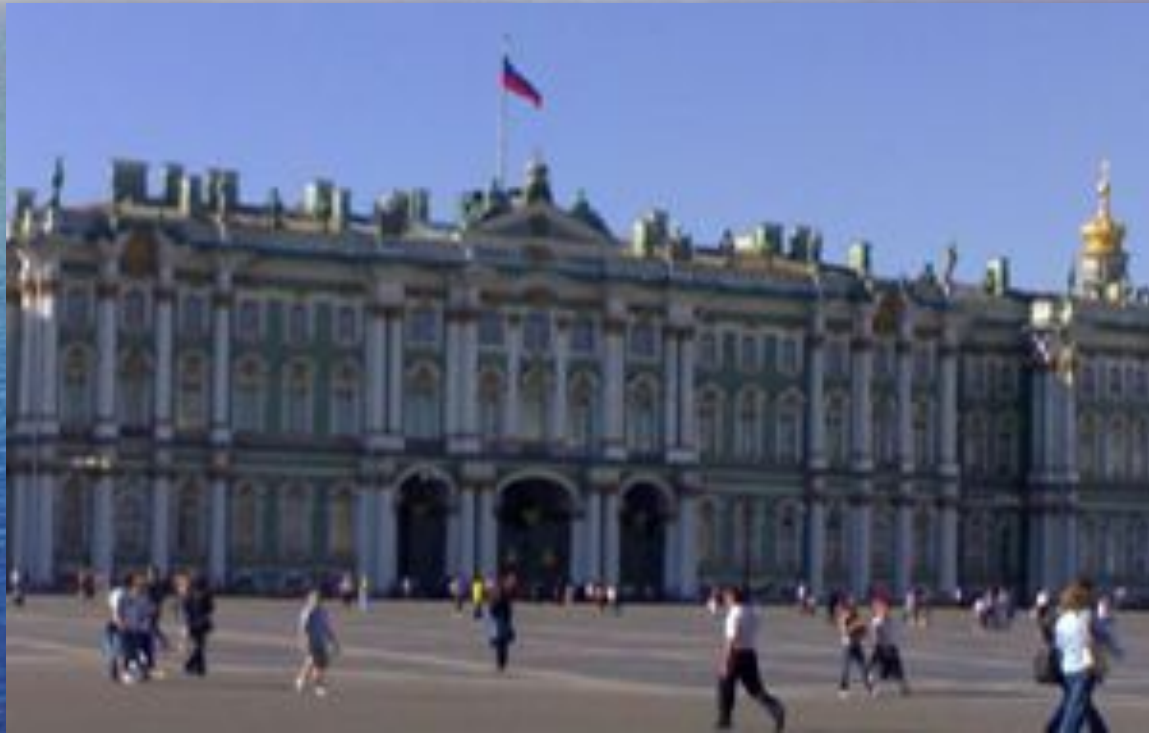


The St. Isaac's Cathedral was the largest church of Russia, and the third largest Cathedral in the world with the capacity of 13,000 people.
