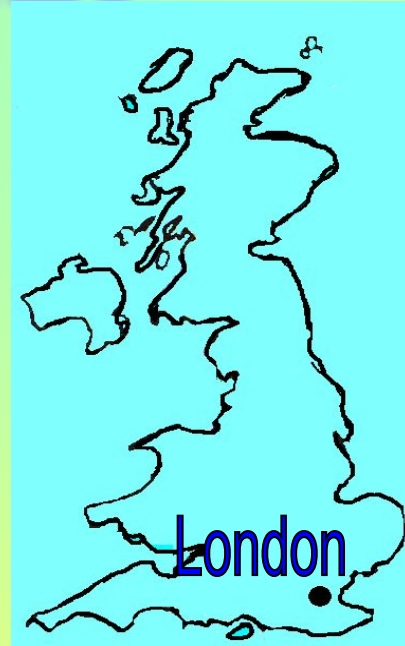

the driest
the whitest
2. The most popular
The most
interesting
