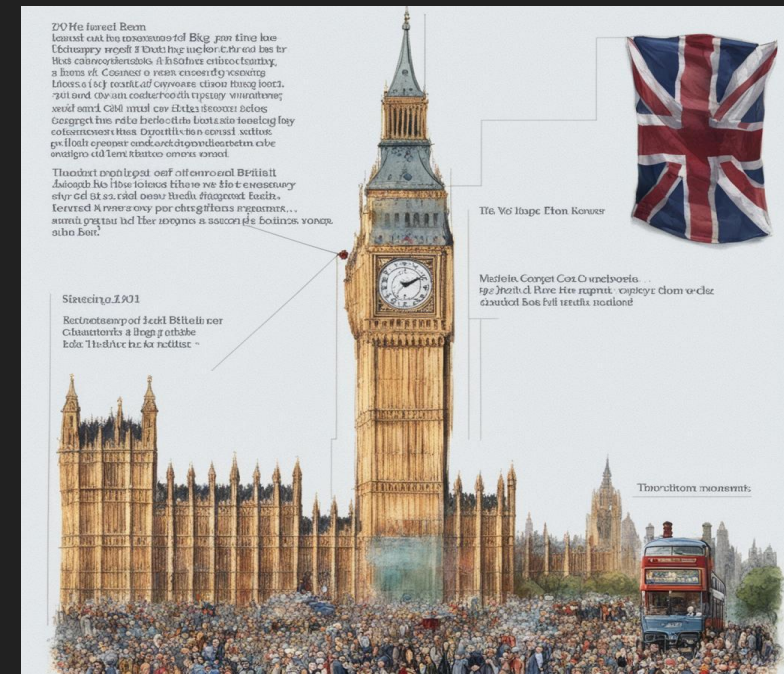
Big Ben in London
