

- После must смысловой глагол употребляется в форме инфинитива без частицы to.
- You <u>must</u> do it immediately.

- Mustn't употребляется, когда запрещено что-либо делать (правилом, законом).
- You <u>mustn't</u> talk loudly in the library.

Have to

1. Выражает обусловленную обстоятельствами

необходимость (вынужден).

- The vet says we <u>have to</u> give some medicine to our dog.
- She <u>has to</u> wake up at 6 a.m. tomorrow.

2. Had to – форма прошедшего времени для must и have to.

You <u>had to</u> do it yesterday.

- 3. don't have to/ doesn't have to употребляется, когда нет необходимости делать что-либо.
- You <u>don't have to</u> buy extra bread.
- He <u>doesn't have to</u> wake up early.

- 4. didn't have to прошедшая форма для don't have to/ doesn't have to
- They <u>didn't have to</u> go shopping yesterday.

<u>Can</u>

возможность что-нибудь сделать (могу, умею)

- I <u>can</u> play the piano.
- He <u>can</u> answer the question.
- I <u>cannot</u> swim. (я не умею плавать)
- He <u>cannot</u> understand.
- <u>Can</u> you sing?
- <u>Can</u> you help me?

•Could – прошедшая форма от can

- •I could not ski when I was little.
- She could not jump so high.

May

Разрешение (можно)

- You may take my pen.
- You may not touch it. (нельзя)
- May I come in?

Предположение (может быть)

- It may rain soon.
- Be careful: you may fall.

Следует

You <u>should</u> work more seriously.

Should + have+V3

• You <u>should have done</u> it. (следовало сделать, а вы не сделали) Must 99% could 75% might 40% can't 99%

- 1. My mum <u>must have done</u> it.
- 2. Ann could have phoned
- 3. He might have taken her mobile phone
- 4. She <u>can't have done</u> it

- You <u>didn't need to buy</u> a ticket yesterday (не нужно было покупать и не купил)
- You <u>needn't have bought</u> (V3) a ticket (не нужно было, а купил)
