




- They learn a lot of interesting things about <u>their</u> <u>lifestyles</u>, <u>cultures</u> and <u>religions</u>.
- Children go to <u>international</u> schools.
- Every day they <u>mix</u> with children who have different <u>religions</u>, <u>cultures</u> and <u>lifestyles</u>.
- Children take part in <u>cross-cultural</u> projects.
- They communicate with one another <u>by sharing</u> different stories and experiences.
- They also take part in different <u>activities</u>
- to learn more about other cultures, lifestyles and traditions;
- to understand how <u>big the world is</u> and how <u>many</u> <u>people live on the planet we call home;</u>
- to understand that <u>we are all different</u> and <u>at that</u> <u>same time we are much alike</u>.
