Past Simple



+ I/we/you/they/he/she/it + V **ed** /V2 I cook**ed** breakfast yesterday
I **went** to school yesterday

- I/we/you/they/he/she/it + **didn't (did not)** + V1
I **didn't** cook breakfast yesterday I **didn't** go to school yesterday

? **Did** + I/we/you/they/he/she/it + V1 ? Yes, I **did** / No, I **didn't**
Did he cook yesterday? **Did** he go to school yesterday?
Yes, he **did** / No, he **didn't** Yes, he **did** / No, he **didn't**

Time expressions: yesterday, last (Monday/January, week/year), ago (two hours/days/weeks/years ago)

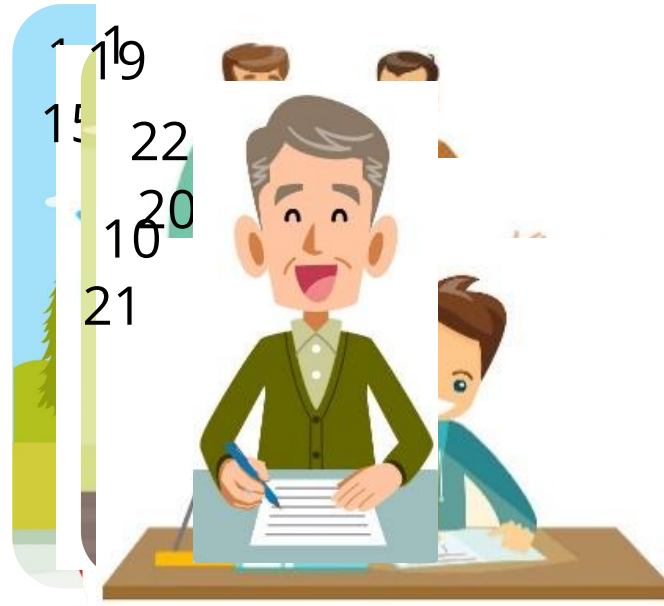

clever - clever**er** – clever**est**

nice-**nicer** – **nicest**

pretty- prett**ier** – prett**iest**

fat – fatt**er** – fatt**est**

Longer Adjectives

interesting – **more** interesting – **most** interesting

beautiful – **more** beautiful – **most** beautiful

Irregular Adjectives

good - **better** - **best**

bad - **worse** - **worst**

The + Superlative adjective + of/in (to compare three or more people or objects)

He is the short**est** of all.

He is the short**est** in the class.

Comparative adjective + **than** (to compare people or objects)

Elephants are bigg**er** than monkeys
