


#### Past Simple

- Did + I/we/you/they/he/she/it + V1? Yes, I did / No, I didn't Did he cook yesterday? Did he go to school yesterday? Yes, he did / No, he didn't Yes, he did / No, he didn't





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Irregular Adjectives
good - better - best
bad - worse - worst
