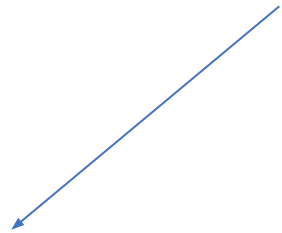

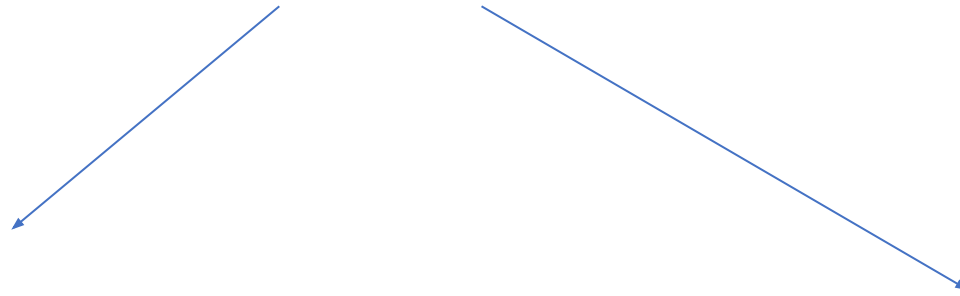

Uncountable



A Countable Noun

consists of people, places, things, or ideas that can be counted.



apple

Uncountable Noun

are not individual objects and cannot be counted.



sugar



milk

bar (of chocolate)
bottle (of water, wine)



bowl (of soup)
can (tin) (of tuna, beans)
carton (of milk, juice)



glass (of water, wine, milk)
jar (of jelly, honey)
loaf (of bread)
mug (of tea, coffee)



packet (of chips, candies)
plate (of spaghetti)
roll (of toilet paper)
tube (of mayonnaise, ketchup, toothpaste)
