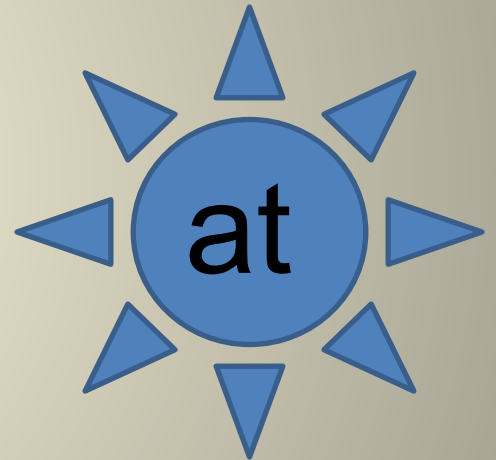
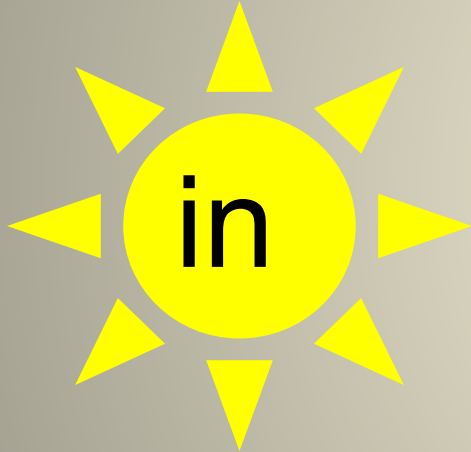

-in September/...;

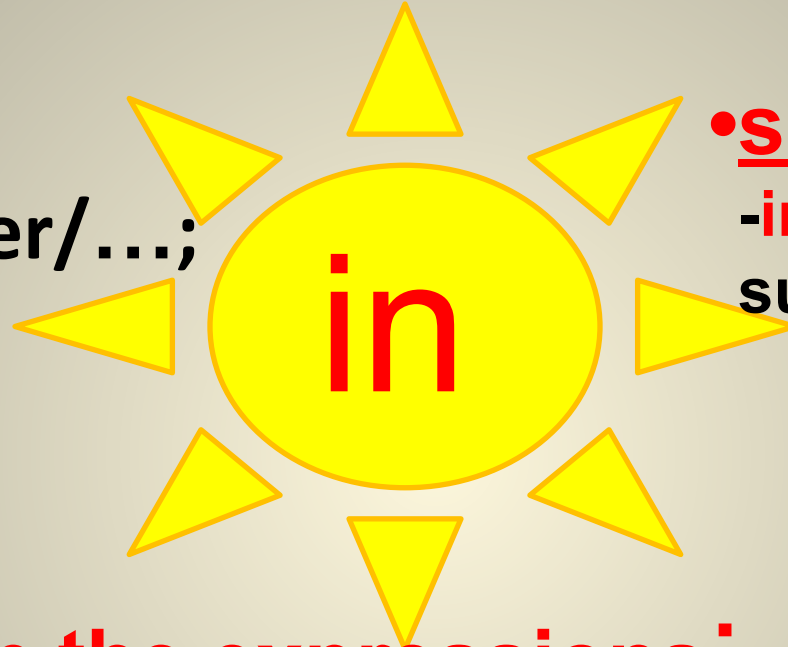

days of the week:

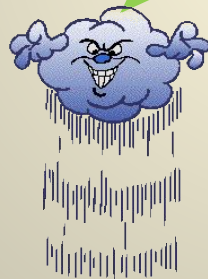
-**on** Sunday

dates:

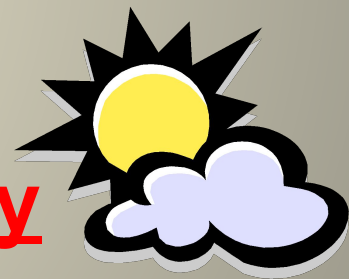
-**on** December **26th**
