
Irregular Plurals



apricots stamps books cats	onions boys dogs days	cabbages places prizes houses

после: sh, ch, s, x -[iz]

brushes, benches, buses, boxes

Ho! potatoes, tomatoes, Negroes -[z]

S - z – iz ?
