other.

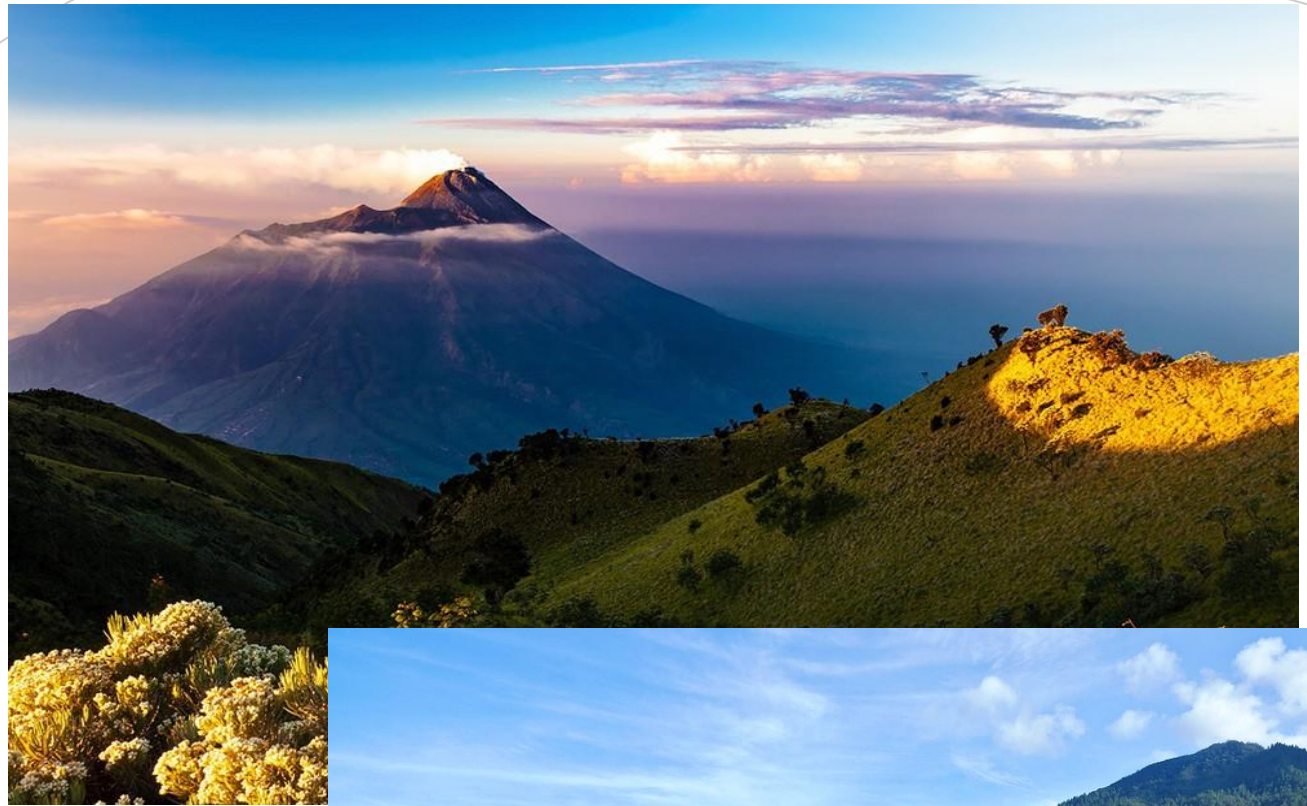
Of all of Indonesia's islands,

inhabited**






***It has 139 volcanoes***
